

Guidelines

It is our privilege to serve you and make your stay pleasant and memorable. For the comfort and safety of all guests, we ask that you please abide by the following guidelines. Anyone failing to do so may be asked to leave the property.

Lake Williamson Property Guidelines and Rules

- No alcoholic beverages are allowed on LWCC grounds.
- There is no smoking allowed on grounds, except in the designated area which is located at the pavilion behind the Activities Center.
- No pets are allowed in any lodge or dorm room. A \$150.00 cleaning charge per day will apply to all violators.
- Please keep off private property.
- Destruction of property is not tolerated. Groups will be charged for damages that occur during their stay.
- Outdoor activities are to be confined to open fields and designated areas.
- Curfew is at midnight. Noise must be keep to a minimum after curfew and all youth are to be accompanied by an adult.
- Cursing or swearing will not be tolerated.
- Wristbands are provided to your group at check-in. All group members must wear their wristbands on their wrists at all times during your stay at Lake Williamson. Please no wearing on ankles or around necks.
- Skateboarding, rollerblading, and skating are not allowed around the buildings.
- No cooking is allowed in lodge or meeting rooms.
- Furniture is to remain as arranged in all sleeping rooms. A charge may be applied to all violators.
- Water fights, silly string, shaving cream, tape on painted surfaces, glitter, or any unauthorized material used for games is not allowed in or near buildings.
- Absolutely no tape/adhesive allowed on doors.
- Only painters tape is allowed on walls. Duct tape, sticky tack, and command strips are not allowed.
- No open flames.

Activities Center Guidelines and Rules

- Food and drinks are not permitted in the gyms, weight/exercise room, wallyball court, and no glass containers are allowed in the pool area.
- Swimwear is not to be worn in the front lobby area. You must be fully clothed.
- Running, skateboarding, rollerblading, heelys, and basketball handling of any sort are NOT allowed in common areas.
- Black-soled tennis shoes and street shoes are not permitted on any court floors unless they have been approved by an Activities Center attendant.
- Parents and/or counselors are responsible for children/youth under their supervision.
- Anyone caught vandalizing or damaging the Activities Center will be held responsible.

Athletic Equipment

Athletic equipment is stored at the Activities Center front desk. Equipment is available for groups to use at no charge. Use of basic recreation facilities and equipment is first come, first serve. If your group would like private use of a recreation activity, please be sure to schedule it in advance with Conferences Services. Groups are responsible for ensuring that all equipment is returned in good condition at the conclusion of the activity.

*Htayrides

- 1. Trips last about 20-30 minutes
- 2. Trips are either around the lake and back to the Activities Center or one way to a bonfire site (guests must walk back).
- 3. Maximum capacity per wagon is 15-20 people. (2 wagons are pulled at a time.)
- 4. An adult attendant must be present on each wagon trip with youth or children.
- 5. No standing, pushing, roughness, or throwing of hay is permitted.

Mini Golf (outdoor and blacklight)

Located near and in the Activities Center.

- 1. An adult attendant must be present during use.
- 2. Suggested Scoring rules:
 - 5 stroke limit per hole.
 - The ball nearest the hole putts first.
 - Par for each hole is noted on score card.
- 3. Adult attendant must check out/return equipment and see that proper care of equipment is observed.

*Indoor/Outdoor Pool

Indoor pool is located in the Activities Center. Outdoorpool is located between the beachfront and RV park.

- No one is allowed to enter the pool alone.
- Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a lifeguard reserved for your group.
- The posted & stated safety rules must be observed:
- 1. No running, pushing, or tripping allowed
- 2. No rough play in or near the water
- 3. No eating or drinking in the water. No glass objects are allowed in the pool area.
- 4. No diving allowed in the indoor pool.

Fishing

- Fishing may be done off the dock near the Dining Room, along the dam, and from the bank in the lot across from the beachfront.
- 2. No one is to fish on private property.
- 3. A license is not required.
- 4. Please only fish in designated areas.

Archery

Located near the Activities Center.

- 1. An adult attendant must be present during use.
- 2. NEVER draw an unarmed bow.
- 3. All spectators remain behind archer.

*Beach

- 1. Beach activities are only open when lifeguards are present and have announced that the Activity is open.
- 2. Posted rules/directions of LWCC lifeguards/attendants must be obeyed.
- 3. No rough play in or near the water or the boardwalk.
- 4. No swimming allowed beyond rope.
- 5. No diving off the dock or boardwalk.
- 6. Lifejackets must be worn for all activities except in the shallow end of the lake & on the Plunge Waterslide.
- 7. Helmets required on Plunge Waterslide.

*Boating

Boat docks are located on the beachfront. We have two and four passenger paddle boats, as well as canoes.

- A Lake Williamson attendant MUST be present during boating times.
- 2. Posted & stated safety rules must be observed or boating time will be forfeited.
- 3. Each person must wear a life jacket.
- 4. Guests must remain seated. No exiting or tipping boats.
